Postponement of Korea International Water Week 2020

New dates: September 21st – 23rd 2020

The co-hosts and the organizer of the Korea International Water Week (KIWW) have been carefully monitoring the implications of the COVID-19 outbreak over the past few weeks. Due to serious health concerns and newly imposed travel restrictions, we have decided to postpone the KIWW 2020, previously scheduled for May 11th to 13th at EXCO in Daegu, Rep. of Korea, to the new dates of September 21st to 23rd 2020, at the same venue.

Considering the past four editions of the KIWW, thanks to your attention and contribution, we have developed our programs and structure based upon diversified interests of global water multi-stakeholders, in particular policy makers and practitioners. We have set up the prioritized global water agenda and resulted in strong political commitment to sustainable water management aligning with the SDGs by having the high-level meetings represented by the ministers from different countries and heads of the international organizations. We also have identified imminent global water challenges and solutions by catalyzing an insight and practical discussion among experts in science, technology and policy sector. In order to achieve our goals of seeking 'implementation of solutions,' we are heavily relying on having key political leaders and decision makers with academic and practical experts at the site.

For the 5th edition of KIWW, the co-hosts are happy to announce that we jointly host the XVII World Water Congress (WWC). The co-hosts and organizers will make their best efforts to bring a better platform based on the values of two important events at the same venue to the participants.

While we deeply regret any inconvenience this necessary change in dates may cause, we firmly believe that the postponing the KIWW will make better opportunities to build a partnership with more diverse partners and to have major water organizations with distinguished experts and delegates.
